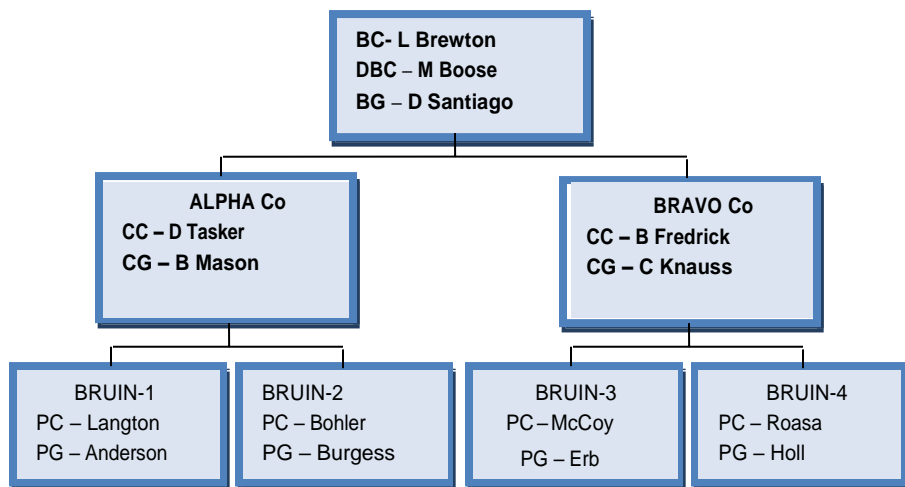

Chorus

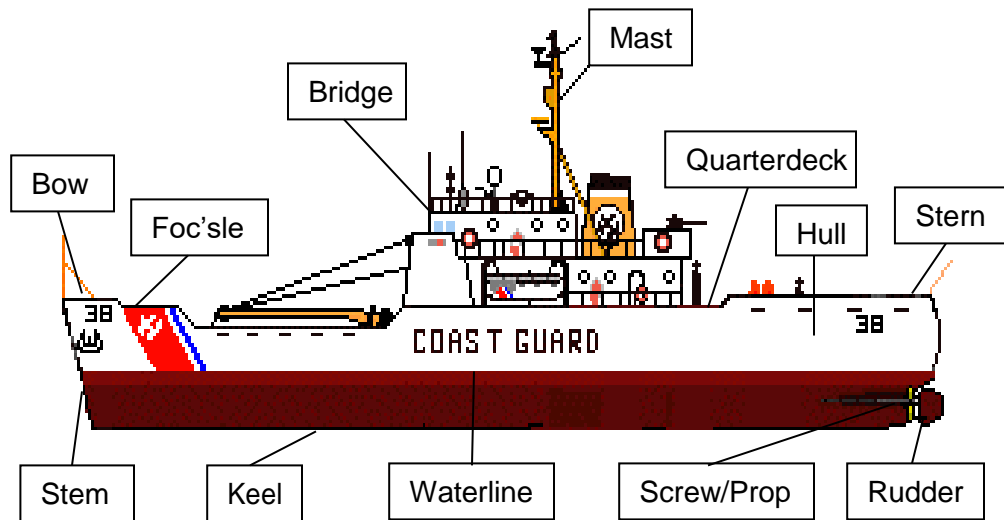
We’re always ready for the call.

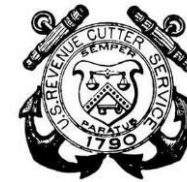

the world.*

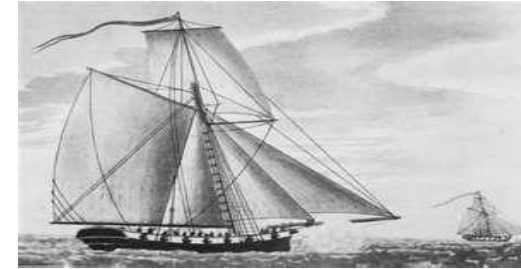
*I never, by word or deed, will bring disgrace upon the name of
